## **Instructions and Rules**

The object of the game is to not be the last player with cards left

## Set Up:

- 1. Shuffle and deal 3 cards, **facedown, in a row** in front of each player. These cards cannot be looked at.
- 2. Deal 3 more cards, **face-up**, on top of the 3 cards in front of each player; these 6 cards form the garden.
- 3. Deal each player a hand of 3 cards, and place the remaining cards, facedown, into a draw pile.

4. Players may switch cards in their hand with the face-up cards in their garden. Once play begins, players cannot adjust the cards in the garden.

Tip: High numbers and specialty cards are preferable in the garden.

## On Your Turn:

- The player with the lowest number in their hand begins play by playing that card and drawing a card from the draw pile; play then continues in a circle
- If the discard pile is empty: play any card from your hand

Tip: Generally, you will want to play your lowest card

- If the discard pile has cards: play a card of equal or higher value to the top card or a specialty card
- You may always play multiple of the same card together

- If after playing your card(s) your hand contains less than 3 cards, take cards from the draw pile until you have 3 cards in your hand
- If you cannot play a card of equal or higher value or a specialty card, you must pick up the whole discard pile and add it to your hand
- Specialty cards: Plant Restarts the discard pile when played, the player immediately follows the plant card with another card(s) on top;

**Harvest** - Permanently removes the entire discard pile from play

- If one or more players play all 4 of the same number in succession, the discard pile is harvested and permanently removed from play
- It is then the next player's turn

## End of Game:

1. When the draw pile is gone, players continue to play the cards in their hand until they are gone.

- 2. Once a player's hand is empty, they may play from the face-up cards in their garden. If a garden card cannot beat the pile, the player removes the card from their garden and picks up the discard pile, adding both to their hand. Players must always have an empty hand in order to play any card from the garden.
- 3. All face-up garden cards must be played before the facedown cards.
- 4. Once all the face-up cards are played and a player's hand is empty, players must blindly choose a facedown garden card and play it on top of the discard pile, picking up the discard pile if the card is not equal to or higher in value (or a specialty card).
- 5. Play continues until all players but one have emptied their hand and garden. The last player with cards is the Rotten Tomato.
